Minimum commitment and charge is until the end of the term in which lessons commence.

We will offer 33 sessions over the three term 2019/20 academic year. The number of weekly sessions will vary depending upon the length of each term and other factors e.g. the requirements of the school (*where lessons are school based*). However, an invoice, based upon an estimated 11 teaching weeks will be sent prior to the start of each of the three terms.

* Duration will reduce to 20 minutes when only 2 pupils remain in a standard group.

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Terms and Conditions - Summary (Effective 1 September 2019)

What you need to know

- 33 lessons are offered over a three term academic year. For lessons in school, this may include one performance. For memberships, we guarantee a minimum of 30 sessions (County Groups excepted)
- Fees are payable termly in advance. Eleven lessons are invoiced each term together with any Membership fees and instrument loan charges. The number of lessons actually taught each term may vary from lessons billed but 33 lessons will have been offered by the end of the teaching year. Non payment of fees may lead to the withdrawal of tuition and/or memberships
- Trial lessons are not offered. The minimum commitment and charge is until the end of the term from the date that lessons commence
- Membership of Academy@Maestros and County Groups is a commitment for the whole year and as such, will be invoiced as an annual fee. Membership and benefits may be withdrawn at any time if a student defaults on attendance at rehearsals and concerts/events
- Any shortfall in delivery of the contracted 33 instrumental/voice lessons will only be credited at the end of the academic year. Credits are not applied on a term by term basis
- Lessons missed by pupils due to short term sickness, school trips/activities, revision leave, exams etc. will not be made up or credited. When 5 or more consecutive sessions are missed in the same term due to illness/injury we will credit a maximum of 5 lessons. A medical certificate may be required. When staff miss a session due to illness or travel delay they will do their best to make the session up (e.g. through an extra lesson or a double lesson). Credits cannot be given for termly membership fees.
- When a school cancels a lesson we will endeavour to make up the lesson provided that a minimum of 48hrs notice has been received from the school.
- In the event of an emergency or closure of a school (full or partial) or music centre due to an event outside Maestros control (e.g. a pandemic, flooding, heavy snow or industrial action), where possible lessons/sessions will be made up or credited.
- If closures extend beyond 48hrs Maestros reserves the right to only make up/credit one lesson or session.
- Lessons taken in school will usually lead to pupils being withdrawn from their normal school classes
- Standard group lessons last for 30 minutes. Exceptionally, at our discretion, we will teach 2 pupils for 20 minutes (standard group rate applies). Group size and length may change without notice
- Maestros staff are not responsible for fetching or escorting children to and from lessons
- Maestros only accepts responsibility for pupils during the actual lesson time
- Maestros does not accept liability for loss of or damage to pupils' instruments or personal possessions
- Parents/carers agree to provide music and accessories as required, to pay any examination fees and to make arrangements for accompanists where required
- Membership of ensembles, bands and choirs is determined by teaching staff. An annual audition may be required for senior ensembles
- **Lessons and memberships continue term on term and year on year until notice of withdrawal is received by the Head Office in Reading via our website.** (<http://www.berkshiremaestros.org.uk/withdraw.html>). Failure to provide the required period of notice for an instrumental lesson will result in a late cancellation charge being incurred up to a maximum of £40.00.
- To withdraw without penalty, notice must be given, via our website, as follows: to withdraw at the end of autumn term by **28 October**; at end of spring term by **17 February**; at end of summer term by **25 May**
- Tuition may be withdrawn in the event of disruptive or anti-social behaviour by either the pupil or parent/carer, poor attendance or failure to practise. No credits will be given
- Maestros reserves the right to change terms and conditions at any time and without notice.
